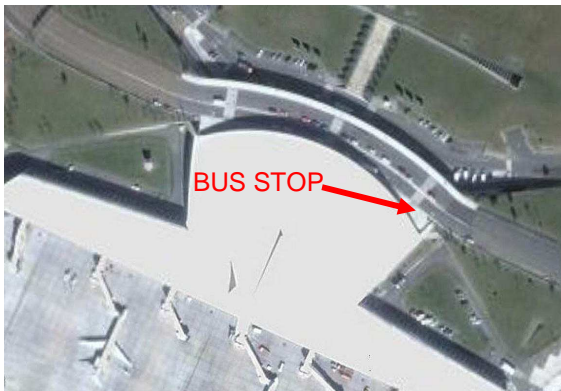


HOW TO ARRIVE FROM BILBAO AIRPORT TO SAN SEBASTIÁN BUS STATION

Bilbao airport, designed by the famous Architect Santiago Calatrava, has only one exit. Turning to the right and walking 30 metres you will find the Bus Stop of the BIZKAIBUS Company (it is the only bus stop in the airport). Wait for a yellow bus labelled “3247 BILBAO-AEROPUERTO” that departs every 30 minutes from 06:15 to 23:15 plus a last bus at 00:00.

The cost of the bus is 1,25 €. Take with you Euro coins or notes of 5€ or 10€. Sometimes 20€ notes are accepted, but 50€ notes will be rejected. Tickets are purchased inside the bus.



The bus stops four times. You should leave in the last stop, the TERMIBUS Bus Station, a provisional modular bus station designed by Architect Nicholas Grimshaw.

Very close to the place where the airport bus stops, there is a company named PESA. Their logo and buses are orange, white and grey coloured. Purchase the tickets in cabins 1 or 2 and take the bus in depots 1-4. People usually buy tickets immediately before the departure, although can also be bought in advance. The cost of the ticket is 8,95€ (notes up to 50€ are accepted). A sit number is indicated in the bottom right part of the ticket. Note that the Basque word Donostia is also used instead of San Sebastian.



Buses depart at 06:30, 07:00, 07:30, 08:00, 08:30, 09:00, 10:00, 11:00, 12:00, 13:00, 14:00, 14:30, 15:00, 16:00, 17:00, 18:00, 19:00, 19:30, 20:00, 21:00, 22:00.

On Saturday 06:30, 07:00, 08:00, 08:30, 14:30, 19:30 buses don't operate.

On Sunday 06:30, 07:00, 08:00, 08:30, 14:00, 14:30, 19:30 buses don't operate.
