

HOW TO ARRIVE FROM SAN SEBASTIAN AIRPORT (HONDARRIBIA)

San Sebastián airport is named Fuenterrabia (Spanish) / Hondarribia (Basque) Airport. It is a small airport placed between Spain and France. From there, a taxi to the city centre costs over 35 Euro. There is a bus stop to San Sebastian immediately on the right of the airport exit. Note that the airport bus first goes to Hondarribia town and from there back to San Sebastián. The last stop in San Sebastián is Plaza Gipuzkoa (over 30 minutes).



Buses cost 2 Euros (take coins or small notes). Buses depart from the airport at:
Monday-Friday: 08:10, 09:10, 10:25, 11:25, 12:25, 13:35, 14:35, 15:35, 16:35, 17:35, 18:35, 19:45
Saturday: 08:10, 09:25, 11:25, 12:25, 13:25, 14:35, 16:35, 17:35, 18:35, 19:45
Sunday: 11:25, 12:25, 13:25, 14:25, 16:25, 17:25, 18:25, 19:35



Once in Plaza Gipuzkoa stay in the garden like in the picture above. Turn 90° to the right and cross two streets towards the Boulevard, the neuralgic centre of San Sebastián.



Cross the Boulevard and find Bus 25 "Benta-Berri-Añorga" (every 20 minutes). Stop in Magisterio (5th stop). Bus 5 also stops there, but takes 13 stops. Ticket costs 1,10 Euro.
